

# Quinn Corridor

Total cost of improvements on the corridor is \$7.2 million.

Quinn Road connects three north/south arterials near the regional shopping mall. Its proximity to traffic generators and its ability to link the major north/south routes make this corridor important. The issues with the corridor are an open canal on south side, lack of pedestrian, bike, or transit facilities and low speed limit. These issues do not stop traffic growth which is predicted to grow from 10,000 to 13,000 vehicles per day.

#### Traffic Issues

- Quinn Road from Teal Road to Pole Line Road is projected to be Level of Service F in 2035.
- Chubbuck Road from Hawthorne Road to Teal Road is projected to be Level of Service D in 2035.
- The intersection of Hawthorne Road and Quinn Road was identified as needing intersection improvements.
- The intersection of Pole Line Road and Quinn Road is predicted to be Level of Service F in 2035 and will need improvements to left and right turn traffic flow.



Additional Improvements are needed to the intersection with Pine Ridge Mall.
